### General Things During Pregnancy

- Iron Supplementation
  - **ferrous sulfate**
  - ferrous gluconate
- **Folic Acid (B<sub>9</sub>)**
- Nausea & Vomiting
  - Vitamins: pyridoxine (B<sub>6</sub>)
  - Antihistamines
    - meclizine (Antivert)
    - doxylamine (Unisom)
  - Phenothiazines: promethazine (Phenergan)
  - Anticholinergics: scopolamine (Scopace)
  - Prokinetic agents: metoclopramide (Reglan)
  - Other
    - trimethobenzamide (Tigan, T-gen)
    - ondansetron (Zofran)
- OTC for Symptom Relief
  - aluminum hydroxide (Amphojel)
  - magnesium hydroxide (Mylanta)
  - magaldrate with simethicone (Riopan)

### Tocolytics

- Beta-Adrenergic Agents: terbutaline (Brethine)
- Calcium Antagonists: magnesium sulfate

### Surfactant Development in the Fetus

- **betamethasone (Celestone)**
- dexamethasone (Decadron)

### Pre-Eclampsia

- **magnesium sulfate**
- **hydralazine (Apresoline)**
- methyldopa (Aldomet)
- **labetalol (Trandate)**

### Induction of Labor

- dinoprostone
- oxytocin (Pitocin)
- carboprost tromethamine (Hemabate)
- methylergovine maleate (Methergone)

#### Postpartum Promotion of Bowel Function

- docusate sodium (Colace)
- bisacodyl (Dulcolax)
- magnesium hydroxide (milk of magnesia)
- senna (Sennakot)
- simethicone (GasX)

#### Things Given to Neonate After Birth

- Rh<sub>0</sub>(D) immune globulin (RgoGAM)
- rubella vaccine
- hepatitis B vaccine
- erythromycin ophthalmic ointment
- phytonadione (Vitamin K, Mephyton)

#### Not to Worry About for NCLEX

- Meds for pain relief during labor
- Anesthetic agents (or types of anesthesia)
- Surfactant therapy in the neonate
